Translation Plug-in from CDAC-GIST

This plug-in can be used to translate website(s) dynamically / on the fly just by the click of a button. It enables a translator / post-editor to contribute / rectify the translations. Translator can contribute new translations after successful login. In order to translate/post-edit, various MT systems are also integrated to aid the translator/post-editor in contributing the right translation. The translator/post-editor can copy and paste the MT suggestions and also can make use of the virtual keyboard to edit or contribute a new translation. Once the translator/post-editor clicks on the contribute button all the new/post-edited contributions will be stored on the big-store on a remote server. Now next time when the same url is loaded, all the previously contributed translations can be applied to the page by just selecting the desired/target language from the plugin button. ... brought to you by CDAC-GIST,Pune
