Localisation deals not just with translation but also catering to cultural nuances and localisation of government websites is essential for ensuring that fruits of e-governance reach the masses.

The LPMF software allows localisation of data, websites (irrespective of back end technology like .net, jsp, php, joomla, word press, etc), various file formats, mobile apk, by using machine translations as an aid for translation. LPMF is powered by the data of more than 200 government websites for which localisation has been undertaken in various languages over last several years.
